Dear Parents and Players,

Thank you for your interest in becoming involved with the Swan Hill Football Netball Club (SHFNC) for the 2024 season. Please read and consider the following information prior to submitting your application.

The criterion for registration is flexible and considers a range of factors including but not limited to:

- Level of family association with the club
- Level of commitment and support to the club by the player and family
- Netball ability
- Attitude and compliance with Netball Victoria Codes of Behaviour for Players and Parents in relation to respect for the club, team, coach and opposition as well as a degree of effort applied during training and games.

Once registrations are finalised, we will look at the number of players registered for each age group and begin training. Each age group will train throughout preseason as a squad. Teams will be then selected by a panel (incorporating the netball coaches and SHFNC committee members).

We are proactive about up skilling our players and supporters in all facets of netball and strongly encourage all players to complete an online introduction to umpiring and or coaching course. Completing such courses help to improve your understanding of the rules and respect for umpires & coaches while also giving you a taste of what these roles involve.

We expect all players and families to be committed and active members of our club. In registering to play there is an expectation by the club that players and families will actively support the club, commit to rostered duties, attend functions and assist wherever possible.

* Please note that participation with SHFNC at the Netta level does not guarantee any player a position in any junior netball team in future years.*

Netball Court Time Policy

U12, U14, U16 and U18 Grades;

Home and Away

During the home and away season each regular player within a team will be rotated to allow each player to have a relatively similar amount of court time. Regardless of any players' age or ability coaches will endeavour to give each player a relatively similar amount of court time over the course of the season.

U14 and U16;

Finals

During the finals series each team's coach(es) will determine which player takes the court in each position and will decide when and which changes will be made. Every player is however guaranteed to play at least one quarter in any finals match that their regular team is participating in.

Eg: If the U16's team is playing a finals match and an U14 player is sitting on their bench, that U14 player is not guaranteed to play one quarter, however every other regular player of the U16's team is guaranteed to play at least one quarter.

U18;

Finals

During the finals series the U18 team's coach will determine which player takes the court in each position, and will decide how long each player remains on the court. This means that some players may not take the court in some final matches.

If a player elects to be unavailable for a particular game(s) during the home and away season, this will likely result in reduced total court time compared to other team members. If a player is unavailable due to injury or illness, this may result in reduced court time.

B Reserve, B Grade, A Reserve & A Grades;

Home and Away + Finals

During both the home and away season and the finals series each team's coach will determine which player takes the court in each position and will decide how long each player remains on the court. This means that some players may not take the court in some matches/finals.
